"Ancient languages are (to be delivered) value systems and cultural expressions and are an essential part of the living heritage of humanity." UNESCO

The founder has (re-)discovered the scientific numeral font in chess as archetype historical language.

The decoding of a programming language is called in informatics "decrypt". The penetration into an encrypted system – in a constructive sense of publications – is called by the present academic computer technology "hacking" by "hackers".

The founder has written 16 volumes about the numeral language in chess: "**Encyclopedia of Chess Prehistory**".

Thus the linguistic Chess cultural values are opened to a wide public,

based on the programs of UNESCO "**World's Languages in Danger**" and "**Memory of the World**".

The prehistoric Chess informations with the added disks are an "archive" of several thousand years of programming language = "archive-worthy documents for conservation, development and imparting of cultural and scientific purposes". The originals are subject to strict data protection according to UNESCO.

Publications are not subject to (secrecy) restrictions,

they are subject to the non-profit license restrictions of 127Chess Foundation.

The 127Chess Foundation is an independent public foundation under civil law of Germany,

with exclusively and directly charitable purposes within the meaning of "tax-privileged purposes" of the tax regulation.

The purpose of the 127Chess Foundation is among other things

- the promotion of science, research and education in relation to the numeral-language chess, as well as
- the promotion of chess sport by those charitable clubs that use the 104-board of arms in the licensed image.

The foundation's purposes are realized by:

- **permanent free publication of the "Encyclopedia of Chess Prehistory"** in German language as a scientific encyclopedia of chess numeral language,
- **to build up an endowed professorship for Chess science (teaching and research) at a German university,**
- the archives material in the sense of European archives laws "to secure, to store and to use".
